2. Open Business

- Security Systems Status -
 - Mr. Miller gave a report on the operation of the cameras. System is up and running now with new cameras operating as expected. The Board discussed creating a protocol for members to make requests for footage. This was discussed in New Business.
- ☐ Common Area Landscaping Status -
